NOTICE TO ELECTORS: THIS BALLOT MAY BE INVALID UNLESS INITIALED BY 2 ELECTION INSPECTORS. IF CAST AS AN ABSENTEE BALLOT, THE BALLOT MUST BEAR THE INITIALS OF THE MUNICIPAL CLERK OR DEPUTY CLERK.

To vote for the candidate of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name like this . To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and completely darken the oval to the LEFT. To vote on a question, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of "YES" if in favor of the question, or completely darken the oval to the LEFT of "NO" if opposed to the question.

STRAIGHT PARTY	STATEWIDE (Cont.)	CONGRESSIONAL (Cont.)
If you desire to vote a straight party ticket for all statewide, congressional, legislative, and county offices, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the party of your choice. A straight party vote cannot be cast for Independent candidates. To vote for individual candidates of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the name. When voting for governor and lieutenant governor, you may vote only for the candidates on one ticket jointly or by writing in the names of persons on the lines provided and completely darken the oval to the LEFT.
